

I have assumed that the ring binder will take up 1 cm.

The main content is guttered to allow for the binder.

The back cover is in 3 parts:

The back cover,

A spine,

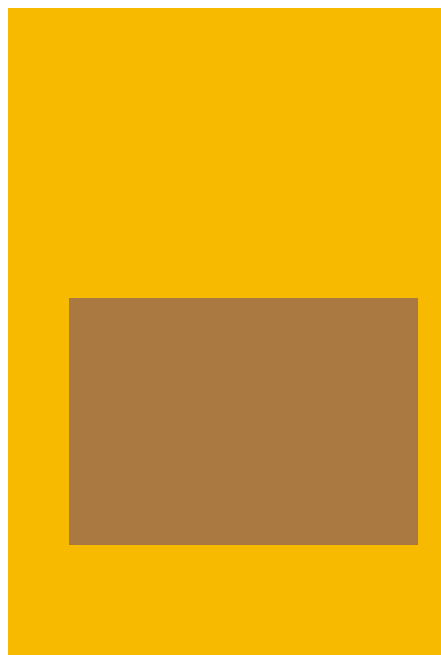
A flap.

The idea is to print on large enough card so that the back cover folds around the pages of the book and under the front cover. The flap and spine go to the left of the back cover.



The binding is on the right for the back cover. The cover is folded to form the spine and flap.

Front cover is straightforward. Design allows 1cm for binder on the left.
